

Accessing CMI data storage

Directly accessing data from CMI machines is now prohibited and usb ports have been disabled.

First contact cmi@nuigalway.ie to request access to our remote data storage facility.

To map the network drive on a uds machine :

In windows explorer, choose 'Tools', then 'Map Network Drive'.

Choose a drive letter to connect to , i.e. R .

Then input:

\\udsfs_research\store\cmidata\'yourname'

You will then be prompted to enter your uds login and password.

You will then see a folder (your name) on the drive you have just connected to.

You can copy your image data and files to this folder.

You can access this folder from anywhere on campus , once you are connect to the university network via a LAN cable.

If you are on a non-uds machine you need to do the following:

This gives you access to your own folder, which only you and superusers can see. You can access this folder from any campus pc. Also data can be written directly to this folder rather than the host pc , saving you time in copying files across from one place to another.

Most importantly this data is backed up by ISS standard procedures.

For non uds PC:

Use the following path:

\\172.16.2.1\store\cmidata\'yourname'

You will be prompted for a user name and password which is you usual login but in this case you need to tell the system what domain you are using to authenticate ie uds.

\uds\'login id' ie nuig id \uds\0100555s for example
